

FUNDRAISING APPLICATION

The Eagle Scout Service Project Fundraising Application must be used in obtaining approval for service project fundraising or for securing in-kind donations such as supplies or materials.* Send the completed form with any attachments to your local council service center, where it will be routed to those responsible for approval. This may be a district executive or another staff member, the council or district advancement committee, a finance committee, etc., as determined by your council. Only one form is required per service project even if there will be multiple events, participants, or donors.

*This application is not necessary for contributions from the candidate, his parents or relatives, his unit or its chartered organization, parents or members in his unit, or the beneficiary.

Common Issues:

- Fundraising approval is also required for requests to donate materials.
- The **Scout** is responsible for insuring the Fundraising form is approved **PRIOR** to doing any fundraising.
 - **Suggestion:** Get the Fundraising form signed by the beneficiary and unit leader when he/she approves the proposal. When the proposal is submitted to Council, include the fundraising form. Make sure it is well tagged so it's obvious that it needs a signature.
 - Unless you know for sure that you won't need to do fundraising, it's worth getting approval concurrently with the proposal.
